CERTIFYING TRAINING

The Neuchâtel school offers certifying training in watchmaking and polishing.

The watchmaking programs are run through a phase of Watch Technician, then Customer Service Watchmaker after one year. Finally, Watchmaker is the additional year more specialized in manufacturing which allows to arrive at a panel of knowledge worthy of traditional haute horlogerie. The student develops in-depth and specific skills in tool maintenance, diagnosis with defect identification, maintenance, movement adjustment, complete service, polishing, precision adjustment, micromechanics and watch manufacturing.

The Customer Service Polishing Technician is a program that allows the reconditioning, disassembly and reassembly of watch cases and bracelet components made of various base metals according to their technical and aesthetic characteristics.

These certification programs make it possible to reach a high level in watchmaking and polishing careers with specific opportunities in international haute horlogerie.

Note: Certificates – titles recognized for their practical part by the Convention Patronale de l'Industrie Horlogère Suisse (Swiss Watch Industry Employers Federation) / based on governmental orders of the SEFRI (Secrétariat d'Etat à la Formation, à la Recherche et à l'Innovation (SERI - State Secretariat for-Education, Research and Innovation).

COURS À LA CARTE

To complete our offer, the school hosts multipurpose courses. Practical or theoretical à la carte courses can be developed and implemented on demand. Train the Trainer, Complete Service Standard Operation, Chronometry, Balance Hairspring Manufacturing, Chronograph, Turning, as well as modular and specific polishing courses, such as laser welding refilling, are given regularly.

COURSE CURRICULUM

Course description

The 2-week WOSTEP Balance Hairspring Manufacturing course allows participants to develop practice and knowledge in precision timing and its intricacies. Participants will learn how to perform all actions in order to fit, count and shape a metal alloy hairspring on a standard annular balance wheel.

C06 – WATCHMAKING - BALANCE HAIRSPRING MANUFACTURING



Duration: 2 weeks

Main topics

Assembly

- Regulating organs assembly
- Fitting a new balance staff

Adjustments

- Performing the truing and poising of balance wheels
- Colleting, counting and shaping a metal alloy hairspring
- Using Leroy's formula to align the inner and the outer pinning point of a hairspring
- Adjusting and manipulating the hairspring to match the bridge regulating device

Fine timing

- Performing dynamic poising of the balance assembly
- Achieving COSC chronometry standards

Career opportunities

With the *Balance Hairspring Manufacturing* course participants will develop their skills in counting and shaping metal alloy hairsprings, in order to carry out restoration work as well as set up prototypes. The course will enhance their repair skills and comprehension of mechanical watches.

Requirements and target audience

The *Balance Hairspring Manufacturing* course is open to all participants who have attended a watchmaking school and have a complementary experience in watch repairs.

Watchmakers with no equivalent educational background or training, must have a minimum of 3 years full-time experience in watchmaking.

The participants need to possess the fundamentals skills and experience as performed in the *Chronometry Adjustments* WOSTEP course.

We strongly stress the fact that these requirements are necessary in order to fully benefit from the *Balance Hairspring Manufacturing* WOSTEP course.
